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## **AWAKE BREAST AUGMENTATION PREOPERATIVE MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

### **MORNING OF DAY PRIOR TO SURGERY:**

- 1) Start your antibiotic**

### **DAY OF YOUR SURGERY**

- 1) Take your antibiotic that morning.**
- 2) Bring in your Norco medication- you will take 1 tablet orally after your measurements are taken and prior to your surgery-Helps with pain after surgery**
- 3) Bring in your Valium medication- you will take 1 tablet orally after your measurements are taken and prior to your surgery-Helps relax you during your surgery**
- 4) Bring in your Catapres medication- you will take 1 tablet orally after your measurements are taken and prior to your surgery-helps with your blood pressure during surgery**
- 5) Bring in your Pepcid medication- you may get the prescription filled by a pharmacist or buy it over the counter(it may come as 10 mg tablets over the counter so you will need 2 tablets)-Helps with indigestion from your medications**
- 6) Bring in Benadryl 25 mg- over the counter medication-Helps prevent itching after surgery**

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## **AFTER SURGERY**

- 1) Complete your antibiotic until it is gone over the next 6 days**
- 2) Take your 20 mg Pepcid orally and daily over the next 6 days**
- 3) You may take 2 tablets of plain Tylenol 500 mg every 6 hours as needed for pain after your surgery. If something stronger is needed, you may take 1-2 tablets of Norco 5 mg every 4-6 hours as needed for pain. Please remember that Norco has 325 mg of Tylenol(acetaminophen) per tablet in it, and you should never take more than 4000 mg of Tylenol(acetaminophen) in any 24 hours to prevent liver toxicity**
- 4) Take your Flexeril x 5 days after surgery to help with any chest muscle spasms**
- 5) You may take the Compazine as needed for nausea and or vomiting after surgery**
